Return Visa

Conditions to apply for a 'return visa':

- 1. Your residence card is still valid.
- 2. You did not exceed the period of absence from the Belgian territory:
 - If you are **F, F+ card holder** and you did not exceed the one-year period (two[1] year period for F+ card holders) of absence from the Belgian territory → you can apply for return **visa type C**.
 - If you are **A**, **B**, **C**, **D**, **H** card holder and you did not exceed the one-year period of absence from the Belgian territory → you can apply for return **visa type D**.

If you are (A, B, C, D, H) card holder and you meet only one of the above-mentioned conditions, you need to provide a proof of payment of the administrative fee (see point 3) when applying for a return visa.

If you do not meet any of the conditions, you can apply for 'return authorization'.

In case of loss or theft, please cancel the card immediately through DOCSTOP: www.docstop.be

Required documents:

- 1. National passport into which a visa can be affixed and which is valid for at least 12 months from the date of application. Must have at least two empty pages.
- 2. Completed and signed national Belgian application form with 2 recent color photograph (5x3cm) with white background glued to the application form Welcome to VFS Global | vfsglobal
- 3. Copy of proof of payment of the contribution covering administrative costs.
 - Only for type D return visa (A, B, C, D, H cards): proof of payment of the administrative fee. Details about the administrative fee are available on the website of the Immigration Office | IBZ
 - *The applicant is exempted if he has a valid residence card and left Belgium less than 1 year ago (right of return).
 - *Minors are exempted from paying the administrative fee.
- 4. The document to choose the language in which you would like to be informed about the decision in your visa application <u>Use of language in administrative matters (1).pdf</u>
- 5. Copy of the identity page of your passport with all used pages in the passport
- 6. Copy of the Belgian residence card
- 7. Proof of last exit from Belgium (e.g. ticket, copy of exit stamp in the passport)
- 8. Declaration of loss or theft from the police station legalized/apostilled by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs (if applicable)

- 9. In the case of a prison sentence:
 - an extract from the judicial record
 - an act of conviction
- 10. Applicant can provide additional documents if he/she finds it necessary to support his/her application

Remarks:

- **1.** The applicant has to submit his/her application by him/herself. (All the documents issued by a government authority should be submitted in original)
- 2. Please make TWO copies (legible) of all documents mentioned above (front and back). Documents have to be arranged in the above order and are to be submitted in 2 separate files.
- 3. Additional documents, even if not featured in the list above, may be required by the Embassy.
- 4. The administrative and visa fee is non-refundable if the visa is denied.
