

Visa D - for COHABITATION with EU citizen (NON-BELGIAN)

Required documents:

1. National passport into which a visa can be affixed and which is valid for more than 12 months
2. Completed and signed national Belgian visa application form with 1 recent color photograph (5x3cm) with white background glued on the application form [Welcome to VFS Global | vfglobal](#)
3. Copy of the identity page of your passport
4. Copy of proof of payment of the contribution covering administrative costs.

5. The document to choose the language in which you would like to be informed about the decision in your visa application : [Use of language in administrative matters.pdf](#)

A) From the partner to be joined in Belgium

6. Copy of the residence permit (front + back)
7. Proof that the person being joined has sufficient accommodation: Copy of proof of ownership of a house/apartment or a copy of the rental contract.
8. Proof that the person being joined has stable, regular and sufficient means of subsistence to meet his own needs and those of the members of his family and avoid them becoming a burden on the public authorities. 9. Proof that the person being joined holds health insurance covering the risks in Belgium for himself or herself (mutualiteit/mutualité)

B) From the visa applicant

10. Copy of Private travel insurance of the visa applicant, valid in Belgium and covering a minimum of 30.000€ medical costs for a minimum period of 3 months. Please refer for the list of recognized local insurance companies via following link: [Updated list Insurance Companies-Mar-26](#)
11. Medical certificate from our panel doctor attesting that the applicant is not carrying any of the diseases which might endanger public health [Certificat médical | IBZ](#)
12. Certificate attesting to the lack of any convictions for crimes or offences under common law (National Police clearance certificate from passport office + Apostille from MEA)

C) From both partners

13. Certificate of civil status proving that you are not married or in an official partnership at the moment
14. Proof of stable and permanent character of your relationship (photographs, letters, mails, telephone bills, money transfers, copies of previous visas and immigration stamps, signed declarations of friends and relatives, proof of holidays together, etc.)
15. Proof that both partners are > 21 years old

Remarks:

1. The applicant has to submit his/her application by him/herself. **(All the documents issued by a government authority should be submitted in original)**
2. Additional documents, even if not featured in the list above, may be required by the Embassy.
3. The visa and retribution fee is non-refundable if the visa is denied.
4. You can submit your application at the earliest three months before your planned visit: : [Visa with the purpose of marriage or cohabitation in Belgium | IBZ](#)
5. The type of visa is a D-type visa (long stay). Once the cohabitation is registered in Belgium the applicant will receive a Belgian residence card with which he/she can stay in Belgium;
6. Please note that the city hall in Belgium might require your original legalized birth certificate upon your registration in Belgium.
7. A later change to the purpose of the visit is not admissible. A prolongation of the visa is not possible. In both cases, a new application has to be entered.
