

Visa D WORK (more than 90 days) UNIQUE PERMIT

The procedure for obtaining a SINGLE authorization for BOTH staying AND working in Belgium

- **From 01/01/2019**, the third-country national who wishes to work in Belgium for more than 90 days will submit to the relevant Regions, **through his employer**, a single application for a work and residence permit.
- If the work permit and the residence permit are granted respectively by the Region and the Immigration Office. The third-country national will receive a single document stating that he is allowed to stay more than 90 days in Belgium to work there.
- Upon receipt of the e-mail granting the work permit and the residence permit, the interested candidate may submit his visa application through VFS accompanied by the following documents:

1. National passport into which a visa can be affixed, and which is valid for more than 12 months
2. Completed and signed national Belgian application form with 1 recent color photograph (5x3cm) with white background glued to the application form [Welcome to VFS Global | vfsglobal](#)
3. The document to choose the language in which you would like to be informed about the decision in your visa application : [Choice of language](#)
4. Copy of the identity page of your passport
5. **Copy of the mail granting the work permit**

IMPORTANT: the applicant will have to come in person to VFS in order to register his/ her biometrics

Remarks:

1. Additional documents, even if not featured in the list above, may be required by the Embassy.
2. The visa fee is non-refundable if the visa is denied.
3. A later change to the purpose of the visit is not admissible. Prolonging the visa is not possible. In both cases, a new application must be entered.
